

2013 Seniors Masters National Championships November 3-7, 2013 West Palm Beach, FL



This year's singles champions Mike Zuro, Masters Champion Flight, and Michael Todorovich, Seniors Championship Flight, are first time winners of the event. Mr. Zuro bested Jackie Jones in a close contest 10 to nine. For the younger players Mr. Todorovich defeated the previously unbeaten Texan Donna Dixon to claim this year's Seniors division National Championship. Both games were played in our famous on-again-off-again Florida fall weather frequently donning rain gear only quickly tear them off because of the heat.

Mike Zuro, whom we haven't seen around our croquet world for so long, returned with a vengeance defeating Dick Sullivan, and then Dale Poszgai, finally had the opportunity to play the finals.
