

2015 USCA Midwest Regional Tournament  
May 22-25, 2015  
Tulsa, OK



The Midwest Regionals was held in Tulsa, Oklahoma, from May 22 thru May 25; sponsored by the Tulsa Croquet Club. We had 31 players and very strong competition in all flights.

Storms were threatening every day, but we were very lucky to only have had heavy rain on Saturday. There were Flash Flood warnings as we left the Tournament Dinner.

We were pleased to have several first time players in Tulsa, who seemed to enjoy being here and they did very well in the tournament.

In Championship Singles, we had 2 blocks with 5 players in each block. It was very competitive with handicaps ranging from -2 to 4.5. Only Matt Smith was undefeated in block play. In Round One of the playoffs, John Brown upset Matt Smith and Kevin McQuigg upset Jeff Caldwell; Matthew Griffith beat Joe Yoder and George Cochran beat Scott Spradling. Round Two had McQuigg beating Brown by 1 wicket in 2<sup>nd</sup> last turn, and Cochran also had a narrow victory over Griffith. In the Finals, McQuigg had Cochran on the ropes, but Cochran made a long hit-in on last turn and pulled out the victory. Congratulations to both for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place.

In First Flight Singles we had 12 players. No one escaped block play undefeated. The block winners were Stuart Coco, a new comer to Tulsa, and Ron Millican. In Round One of playoffs, Harold Menzel beat Ron Millican, Robert Franks beat Tad Cassidy, Deborah Millican defeated Howard Holdsclaw, and Stuart Coco beat Andrée Bothe. In Round Two, Menzel defeated Franks, and Coco defeated D. Millican to set up a final with Menzel and Coco. Menzel won the final by 1 wicket in 2<sup>nd</sup> last turn. Congratulations to Harold Menzel and Stuart Coco.

Second Flight Singles had 6 players. The First Round of playoffs had Jim Loftis over Stephen Jackson and Joe Warren beating Suzanne Spradling. Jim Loftis prevailed over Joe Warren in those Finals. Congratulations to both Jim Loftis and Joe Warren.

Championship Flight Doubles finals was between Matt Smith and Scott Spradling against Matt Baird and Kevin McQuigg. It had rained the night before and in a very wet court, Smith and Spradling took the soggy victory.
